We were reminded of the Cap City Fly-In and Swap Meet on April 30 at their field at Perry Lake.

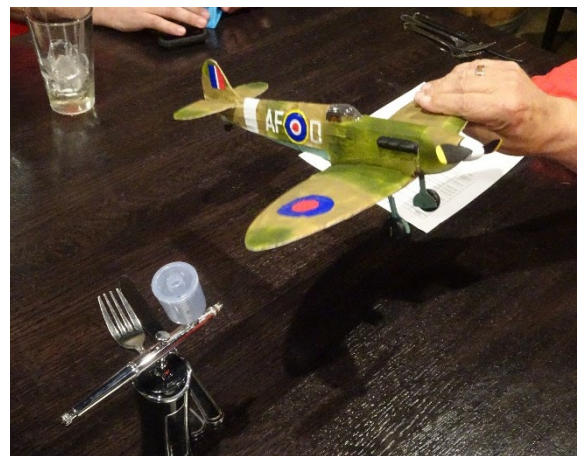
Members were invited to have lunch at Johnny's West on May 12 and 25, and then go out and set up for the Jayhawk Open and the Rocketman Rally after lunch.

He used this slick little battery-powered, rechargeable airbrush-- \$60 on

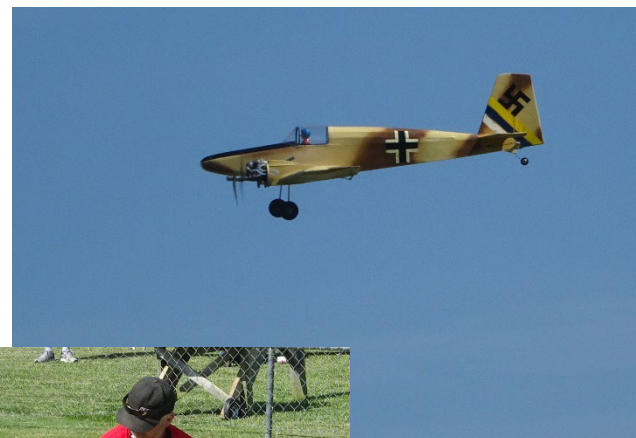
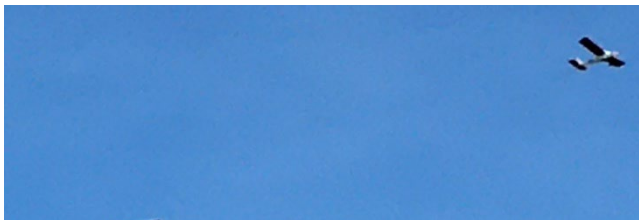


Amazon. He said it worked well, comes apart to clean, and was perfect for painting the little Spitty.

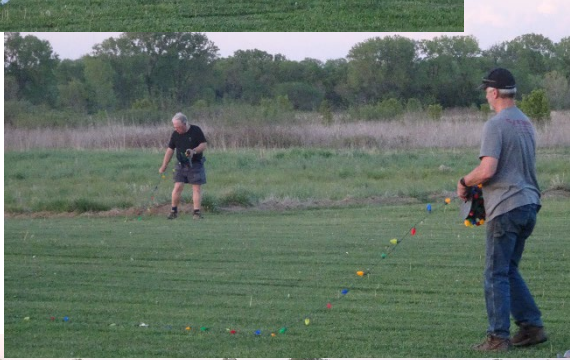

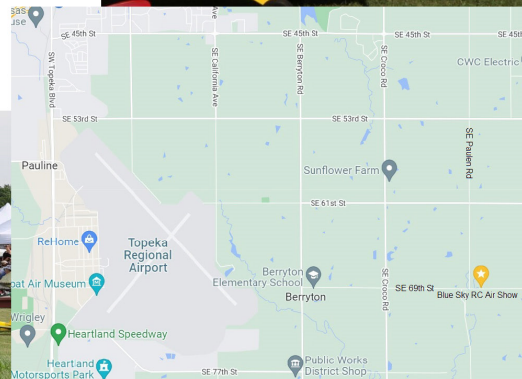
