Minutes: 11/16/91

Bill Elkins was conveniently missing, and the minutes were taken by the YP.

Richard delivered the 92 colanders to those who had signed up for them.

Richard called the meeting to order at 9:13.

Treasury report:

Richard announced that there will be a conquest 6 channel radio raffled at the December meeting.

The central issue of discussion was the site committee's report.

Darrel Anderson expressed doubt that the committee's price information was valid and felt the road/parking lot would be \$1350.00. An incorrect figure was found in the committee report, and the committee's initial estimate was changed to \$900.00. Gary Rockman thought it would be somewhere in between.

Gary Rockman was assigned the task of getting firm pricing estimates on construction costs.

Richard Ballard felt the demolition fund would make it possible to proceed with the project, but pointed out that the current lease will expire in 18 months, insufficient time to fully fund the operation, should we lose the lease in 93. Richard thought the club could afford \$350-\$400 from the treasury.

Jesse Longoria made a motion that the club proceed with the plan provided that funding could be arranged and the corps approves the site plan. Dave Norris seconded the motion and it was approved by all but two members present.

Bill Elkins was appointed to chair the equipment committee. His job will be to arrange the use of club member owned heavy equipment.

Brett Bennett was assigned the task of arranging for the member provided loans, and other financing needs. A 4 year pay back for loans was decided upon. Brett also made a motion that the club dues be raised to \$35/year. Dave Norris seconded this, and the MOTION WILL be voted on during the Dec. meeting.

Chuck Hardman obtained a quote from a local lawn care specialist for mowing. The quote called for 25 mowings at \$32/mowing making it \$800.00. Chuck was assigned the TASK OF trying to get a deal for 21 mowings at \$30 each.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00.

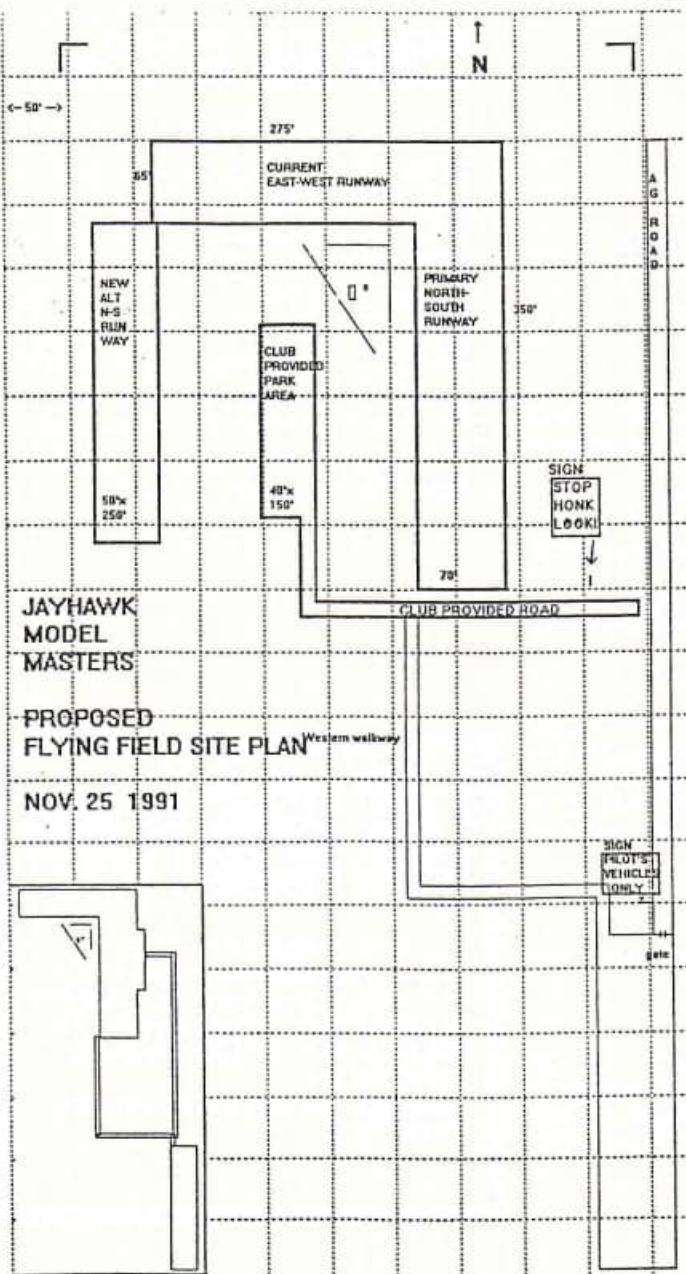
DEE PREZ SAYS

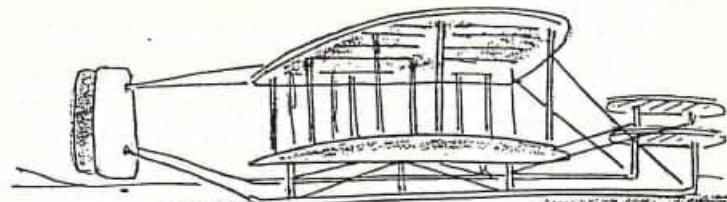

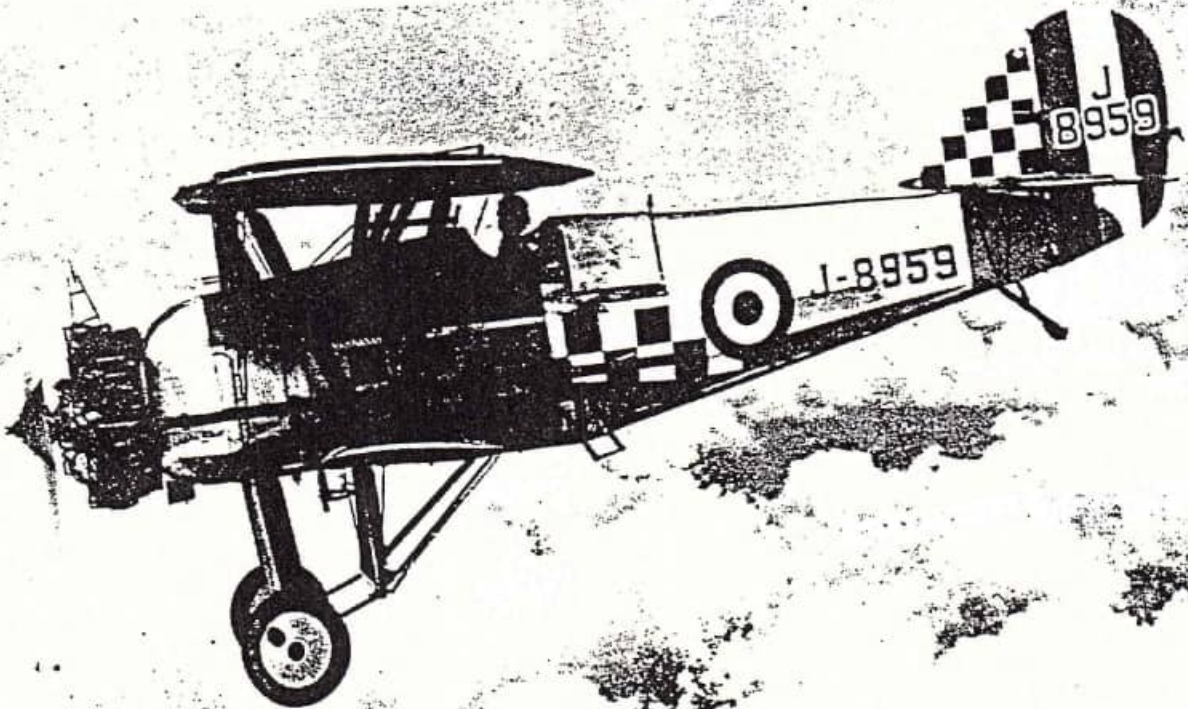
